  - 1-3 actionable ideas and takeaways for participants
  - Outline of main points of presentation (keeping in mind each presentation will be 12-15 minutes)
  - Creativity is encouraged! Attach pictures and screenshots to support your materials as applicable. These attachments will not count against the two-page limit.
